SNOW FOOTBALL RULES

1.

Gametime is 2x4min. Both rounds begin from the middle. The rules are the same as in regular football expect that there are no offsides.

2.

Every team must have 5-10 people and 4 of them will play on the field and one will be the goalkeeper. Teams must be mixed teams, i.e. the team must have representatives of at least two different genders on the field at the same time.

3.

Point will be scored when the ball enters the opposite teams goal. It will not be counted if the ball is played by hand. After scoring the rival team will start the game from the centre.

4.

The free kick will be done at the place of the felony. The opponent must be at least 2 meters away from the ball. If the opponent is closer than that there will be a new free kick and if this repeats multiple times, there will be a caution/dismissal

5.

A penalty kick will be done into an empty goal from the middle.

A penalty kick will be had:

- If a felony is done that's purpose is to prevent a goal (e.g. a hand felony). After a failed penalty kick the game will continue with a goal kick.

6.

Breaking the rules will first lead to a caution and after that a dismissal. In cases of severe rule breaking a player can be dismissed without a caution.

Caution/dismissal will be used as punishment for:

- unsportsmanlike behaviour
- harming or attempting to harm the opponent
- continuous offenses
- continuous judging of the referee
- obviously delaying the game (e.g. purposely kicking the ball outside the field)

Rules of Fair Play will be followed at snow football.
